Students with Additional Learning Support Needs or Disabilities

The College welcomes all students including those with a disability or learning support need providing that you meet the normal admissions criteria and that we can offer an appropriate programme of study, for which you are qualified, together with the right facilities and support. If you do have a learning support need or physical disability the College will endeavour to provide you with the resources and support appropriate to your needs. It is helpful if relevant information can be provided at the earliest possible stage to help us meet your needs, if you need further information please contact Sarah Prince (Director of Learning Support).

We take into account any existing assessment that might have been made at your previous school and, where necessary, arrange for your needs to be evaluated at the College. The Director of Learning Support is available in room 220 to discuss how we can best help you by taking your needs into account. Students with limited mobility have complete access to all buildings on the College campus. Where appropriate your subject teaching staff are informed of any special needs which you may have and the appropriate examination arrangements are made during and at the end of your course. A copy of the College disability statement which gives further information about the provision made by the College in respect of students with disabilities is available from the General Office, Director of Learning Support or your Senior Tutor.
